Mayor Norton called the meeting to order at 4:30pm.

Special Meeting was called to approve a Budget Amendment for the purchase of the Police car that was approved in a Special Meeting on July 29, 2025. Alderman Gentry made a motion to approve the Budget Amendment for the purchase of the Police car; Alderman Stancil seconded the motion; all were in favor.

The Woodfin Police Department has offered to donate a 2016 Police car to the Town. The car has 100,004 miles. All equipment will remain with the car except for the radar. No resolution is needed to accept the car. Mayor Norton asked for a motion to accept the police car from the Woodfin Police Department; Alderman Stancil made a motion to accept the police car; Alderman Gentry seconded the motion; all were in favor.

Mayor Norton told the Board that she would like to have the old car advertised as surplus property: best offer – the car was donated to us from Myrtle Beach. There have been multiple problems with this vehicle since it was received. With this information it was felt there wasn't a need for a minimum bid. We have another car, advertise as surplus; we will look at the Blue Book value, less amount for no air conditioning, and advertise with a minimum bid amount. Alderman Myers made a motion to advertise the Myrtle Beach car in Surplus Property as best offer; Alderman Gentry seconded the motion; all were in favor. Alderman Gentry made a motion to advertise the second vehicle, Blue Book value less air conditioning, Alderman Myers seconded the motion; all were in favor.

Since there is no other business to discuss, Alderman Gentry made a motion to adjourn, Alderman Myers seconded the motion; all were in favor. Meeting adjourned at 4:42pm.
