Mayor Norton called the Town meeting to order at 6:02pm

Mayor Norton

Read the Public Charge.

There was no one on the evening's agenda.

Mayor Norton asked the Board for a motion to accept the November 2022 Town meeting minutes. Alderman Barnett made a motion to accept the minutes; Alderman Moore seconded the motion; all were in favor. Mayor Norton asked the Board for a motion to accept the December 2022 Town meeting minutes. Alderman Gentry made a motion to accept the minutes; Alderman Barnett seconded the motion; all were in favor.

Public Comments

Joey Moore

Mr. J. Moore asked about the music. Said when he is lying in bed, he doesn't want to hear the music. Alderman Moore said hopefully the music problem will be taken care of. Mayor Norton told everyone that the Board has requested the Town's attorney to work on the music problem. Alderman Gentry said the home, in which the amplified music is being played, doesn't have a permit for music as the house is in a residential area of town. Alderman Moore said that law enforcement is to write tickets to the partiers, per the Town's Attorney. Alderman Moore also said that law enforcement can confiscate all the music equipment. Mayor Norton said that Attorney Moore needs to get the information put in writing and provide to the Town Board.

Business

Mayor Norton

Referred the Board to a hard copy of information from MicroCom. The Town had only a one-year warranty for the equipment parts. She asked the Board if they wanted MicroCom to provide the town with a service plan for \$2,500.00, per year. Alderman Gentry told the Board that MicroCom is, currently, not answering the Town's phone calls. She is concerned that MicroCom is not the correct group the Town should be working with. Alderman Gentry said that Jeremy Trantham (with the Town's maintenance department) is going to contact Keith Webb (with mcgill) and let him know MicroCom isn't answering our phone calls. She told the Board that she is not willing to pay MicroCom anything at this point.

Departments

Laura Holloway – Tax Department

Told the Board that at the time, Town had collected 66.60% of the 2022 taxes. At the February meeting, Ms. Holloway will give the Board a list of the delinquent tax payments. She will also begin working on sending out delinquent letters in order to continue collecting tax payments.

Alderman Gentry asked Ms. Holloway if she had contacted Southern Software to create the billing for the 3-people she had been working on. Ms. Holloway advised the billing had not been completed. Alderman Gentry asked if it was possible (legal) to waive interest for the 3 (due to them not being billed for tax years 2020 and 2021). Alderman Gentry said once everything was completed, it would be presented to the Board at next meeting.

Lisa Hicks – Event Committee / Zoning Board

Mayor Norton asked the Board if they were wanting the Zoning Board to work on something. Alderman Moore and Gentry both said yes. Alderman Gentry said she would be attending the Zoning Board's next meeting.


Ken Kashuba – Maintenance

Mr. Kashuba said that regarding MicroCom he knew that Maintenance had been trying to get a hold them. The tank on 25/70 has been giving a bad level reading. Maintenance was concerned that the bad reading may be caused by a bad transducer.
